**NOTIFICATION**

In pursuance of Sub Section (d) of Section 2 of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act 2009, the State Government specifies that the children belonging to Scheduled Cast, Scheduled Tribe and Other Backward Classes communities where parental income is not more than Rs. 1.00 lakh per annum to be ascertained on the basis of the income certificate issued by the competent authority and the children with special need having disability of 40% and above and possessing disability card issued by the competent authority to be the "children belonging to disadvantaged group".

The State Government also specifies that the child belonging to weaker section means a child belonging to such parent or guardian who possess BPL card issued by the Department of Economic, Statistics, Monitoring and Evaluation (DESME).
